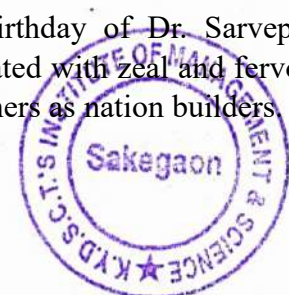
2 Gandhi Jayanthi:

The year of 2021 was the 131st birth anniversary of Ambedkar, who had chaired the drafting committee of the Constituent

11 Safety Day:

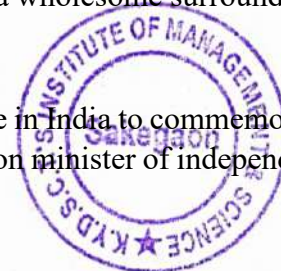
Safety Day is observed to celebrate the foundation of the National Safety Council of India to raise awareness about safety measures and prevent misfortunes.
